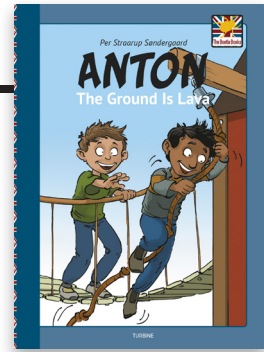



Read page 12-13 again.

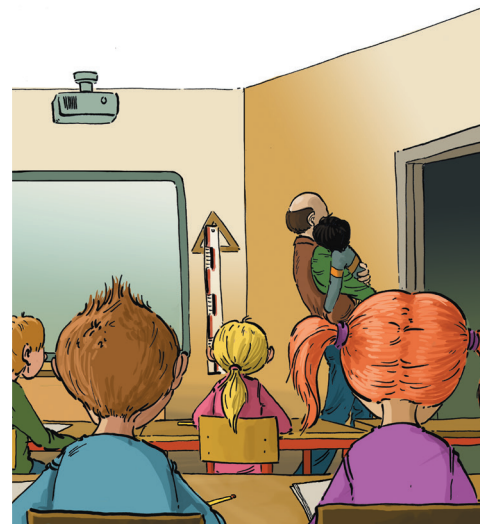
Said has become very scared. What do you think he is thinking?
