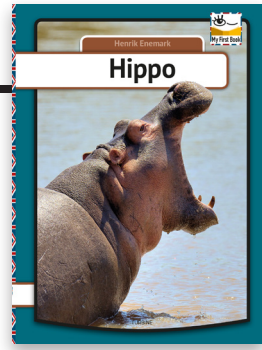

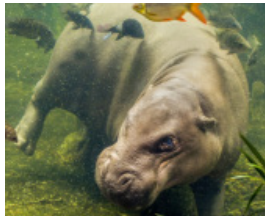
Write about the hippo.

Hippos live in water and on land. Write about what a hippo does in water. And on land.

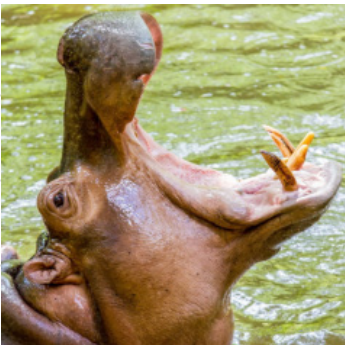


Student Assignments

What are young hippos called?

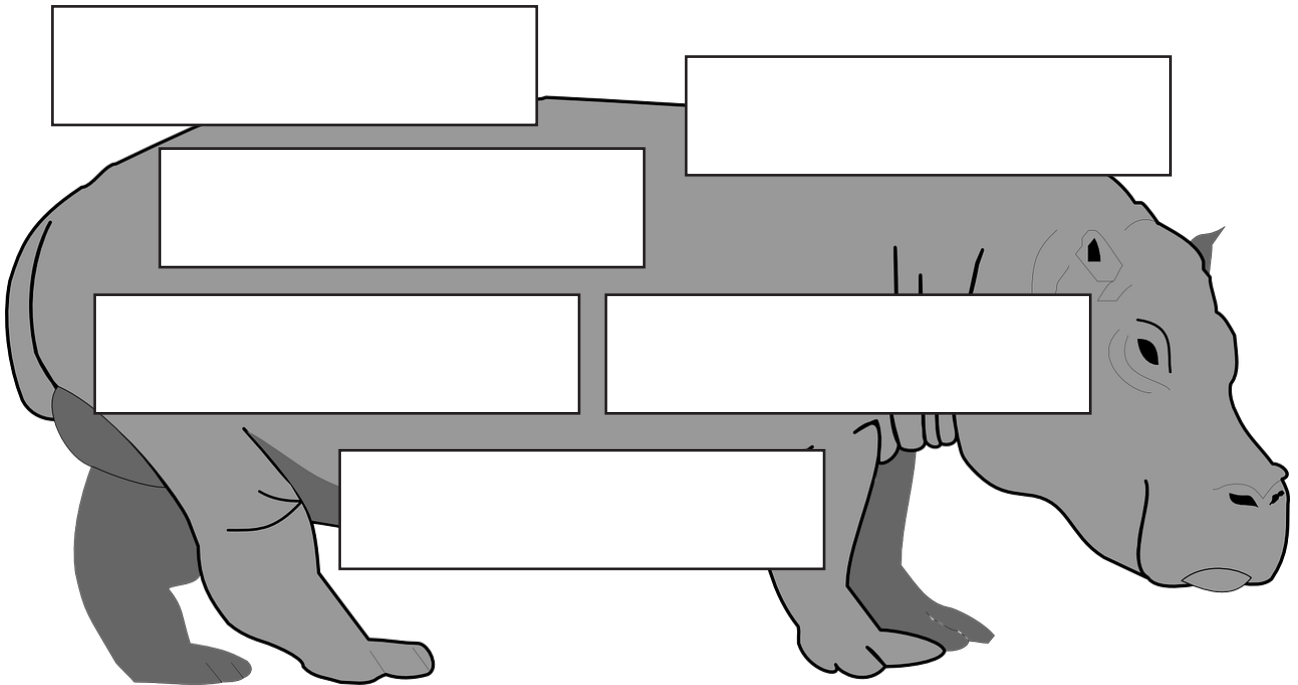
Which words are good to use if you want to search for videos about hippos on YouTube?
