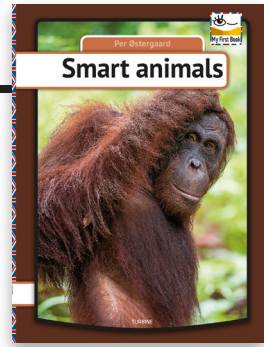

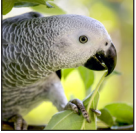

The third line must contain 5 syllables.

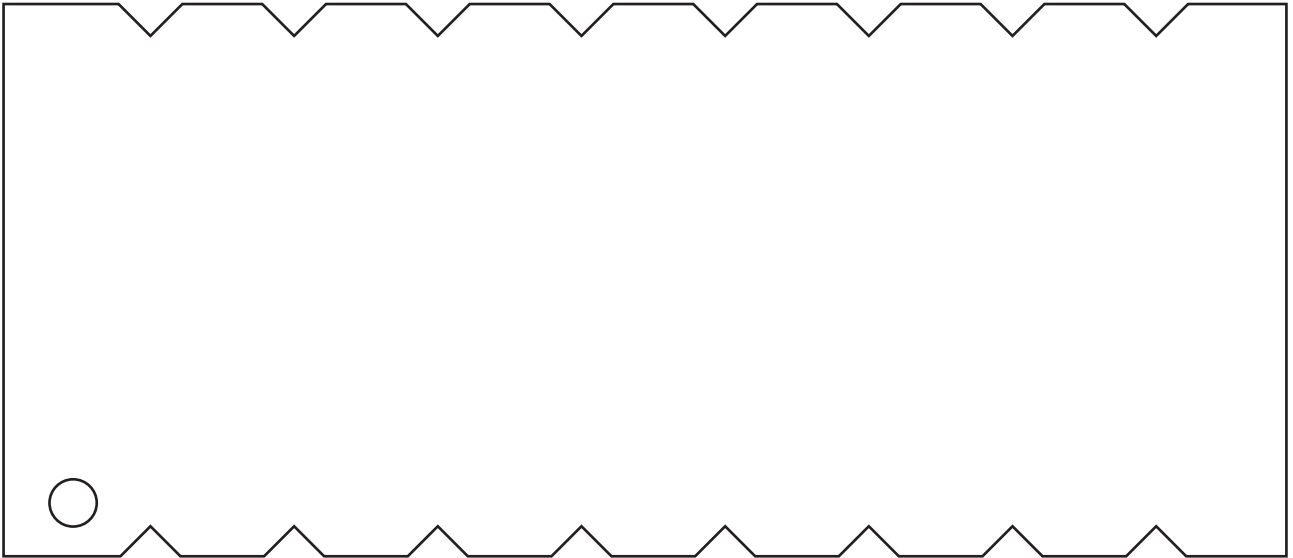
